Judges will select three comics from each audition to move on to the next phase. The videos from each of their auditions will be uploaded to the SiriusXM Top Comic website and Canadians will have the chance to vote for their favourite comic this summer. The eight comedians with the most votes will move on to compete in the Top Comic Finale in Toronto during *JFL42*, presented by Air Canada in association with SiriusXM. A winner will be selected during the finale by an esteemed panel of judges (TBA).

"We're thrilled to bring back the Top Comic competition again this year and proud to be able to expand the grand prize to include more performance opportunities and a substantial increase in prize money," said Ben Miner, Canadian comic and host of SiriusXM's Canada Laughs.
